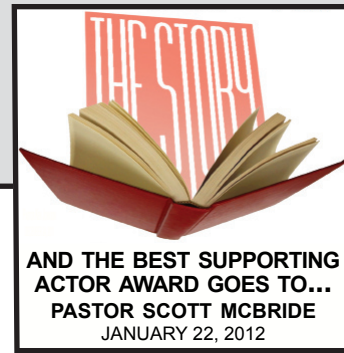

**DAY 2-6 - STUDY**

Day 2: Read Exodus 3:1-14 God wants your heart to be open and available to being a supporting character in His story. How did God respond to Moses excuses. How can you be more open to God's plan?

Day 3: Read Luke 22:1-44 Sometimes God calls us to play a role we don't want to. Are you willing to yield to Him and be the character he wants you to be?

Day 4: Read Exodus 17:1-16 What did Aaron and Hur do as supporting characters in Moses' life? Are there people that you support in this very physical, tangible way?

Day 5: Read Acts 1:1-8 As a supporting character do you find it frustrating not to know all the details of the story to come? How does verse 8 give you something to hold onto as you carry on with God's big story?

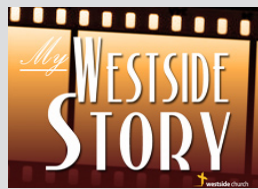
