### DAY 2-6 - STUDY

Day 2: Read Numbers 6:24-26 Is God a personal or impersonal God? What do these verses tell you about God's desire to partner with you during the good and the bad times?

Day 3: Read Psalm 23 How does this Psalm lead you to forget what is behind and press on toward pursuing God?

Day 4: Read Acts 28:26-27 and Mark 4:11-12 What are the keys to knowing God? Pray that your heart may be softened so your eyes can see and your ears can hear and that you may understand God's ways.

Day 5: Read Psalm 27 How is this Psalm related to the scripture we studied this weekend (Philippians 3:10-16)? What parts of this Psalm do you think Paul would have used in his pursuit of 'taking hold' of Christ?

Day 6: Read Numbers 14:1-9 How do your own doubts in God prevent you from pursuing and partnering with God? How can you develop an attitude of contentment about your current life situation?
